Ronald van der Salm, PURE Gerbera:

"Netherlands: "Longer growth on Multigrow rockwool cubes gives financial advantage""

Since the beginning of this year Ronald van der Salm of PURE Gerbera from Delfgauw in the Netherlands, grows a part of his mini gerberas on Multigrow Premium rockwool cubes from Benfried. The increasing trend is to grow on this innovative growing medium (Multigrow Premium is formaldehyde-free).



Larger water buffer

Ronald also decided to reserve a part of his three-hectare large nursery for growing on Multigrow slabs to compare results. The flowers have been harvested for a few months. Van der Salm: "First of all I noticed, that the rockwool retains much more moisture than coconut fibre. The slabs remain wetter. I find this an advantage during the summer. We now can afford to have a problem with the water supply."



Cubes are more sustainable

However, the big difference is, according to van der Salm, that rockwool grow cubes are more sustainable than coco slabs. Van der Salm: "Coco is usable for two years. I can grow longer on rockwool because it is useable for three to four years. This is an economical advantage.



The pot is filled for 80% with grow cubes and on top a rockwool disk is placed to give strength to the plant as quite some force is put on the plant when a flower is harvested.

The nursery comprises of a greenhouse covering an area of 33,200 m2 where both standard gerberas and the mini gerberas are being cultivated in a biologically integrated and sustainable way. We had the privilege of being the first in the Netherlands to have 100% biologically grown plants be delivered.

Out of Delfgauw, The Netherlands the total European market is served. Per year 20 million gerbera flowers find their way to the consumers through wholesalers.



Delivery

The gerbera pots with grow cubes and disk are transported on pallets.
